Deputy Secretary – Agricultural Trade Group (Senior Responsible Official)

The Deputy Secretary receives quarterly updates from NLIS Uplift Governance Group, and at key decision points throughout the project.

ISC / MLA Project Oversight Group

NLIS Uplift Governance Group

The NLIS Uplift Governance Group is a decisionmaking body that provides project governance oversight and strategic direction to ensure delivery of the project.

ISC Senior Leadership Team

The ISC leadership team provides project sponsorship, governance, allocation and monitoring of resources and budget.

Grant Management

The Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry (DAFF) administers the grant agreement and approves milestone payments.

ISC Uplift Project Team

Technical Reference Committee

The Technical Reference Committee provides input into the solution and design elements, participates in showcase workshops, reviews and tests functionality, and provides advice on the release approach, deployment plan, end-user engagement plan, and on the extension and adoption plan.

Commonwealth co-design group

The Commonwealth reference group tests and validates ideas and clarifies the Commonwealth's position, use cases, and requirements.

States and Territories co-design group

The states and territories reference group tests and validates ideas, and clarifies the state/territory position, use cases, and requirements.

Industry co-design group

The industry reference group tests and validate ideas, clarifies the industry position, use cases, and requirements. This group will include participants from each point in the supply chain.

End User Focus Groups

The end user groups will be participants from the supply chain field who will test the designs to elevate user experience satisfaction.
